Use www.aleks.com or https://xtramath.org, for enrichment or fact practice Language Arts/Reading: Super Kids Unit 4 Week 2 stories & skills focus on spelling & reading words with "-igh," "stle," and "-scle." Skills include writing & use past & present tense verbs. For spelling games, use https://www.spellingcity.com/users/MsLong98133 to practice Writing: Editing and proofreading practice; writing friendly letters for Catholic Schools Week; comparing & contrasting winter animals in <u>Scholastic News</u> article, "Prey on Ice" Religion: Second Step lessons focusing on using "self talk" to handle distractions & being assertive; review of "Our Father" prayer Science: In our Mystery Science unit (lesson 3), students explore answers to "Why are so many toys made out of plastic?"
