WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: My Math_Chp. 6: Adding 3-digit Numbers, lessons 6 - 8 (3-digit addition with regrouping & solving story problems). Test on 2/1. Review of counting money & identifying coins. Use www.aleks.com or https://xtramath.org, for enrichment or fact practice

Language Arts/Reading: <u>Super Kids</u> Unit 4 Week 3 stories & skills focus on spelling & reading words with "-old," "-ost," "-ild," "-ind," and short e sounds with "ea" patterns. Skills include writing with suffixes "-ful" and "-less," as well using similes. For spelling games, use https://www.spellingcity.com/users/MsLong98133 to practice

Writing: Editing and proofreading practice; using adjectives and adverbs to make writing more detailed

Religion: Reading & understanding when we pray the "Nicene Creed" prayer; Second Step lessons focusing on identifying feelings & practicing empathy to understand how others feel

Science: In our <u>Mystery Science</u> unit (lesson 4), students explore answers to "What materials might be invented in the future?" Using their knowledge of different materials, as well as the 3 states of matter, they'll design an invention using futuristic materials
