In 1st Eucharist studies, Chp. 3: Jesus Teaches Us How to be Happy focuses on 3 actions that lead to happiness & how the Eucharist creates a friendship w/ God Social Studies (IB unit): Exploring central idea that "Being good stewards of the Earth is our right and responsibility." Activities include evaluating our weekly trash/recycling by creating "trash people" & discussing ways we can reduce the amounts of trash we throw away
