IB Unit of Inquiry

Transdisciplinary theme: Who we are Central idea: Regions are formed based on shared characteristics.

We are continuing our unit on Regions are formed based on shared Characteristics. This week we will be learning about Mexico and Canada. We will do a little reading on each country and then complete a venn diagram comparing the two countries. From there we will be moving on to learning about the United States. The first thing we will be doing is looking at a Physical map of the United States and a map with the outline of the 50 states. We will see if the children can name any of the states and find where they are located on the map. We will be discussing if there are natural borders that separate the states and naming them as we go. An app that we will be using to learn the 50 states and where they are located is called *Stack* the States. When we finish the unit I will be challenging the students to be able to place all fifty states in their correct place on a map so the more practice at home
