This Week's Learning

Fourth Grade ELA

Spelling: Spelling words will be passed out on Monday. The children should practice their words using the ideas on the Spelling Contract Sheet or the Spelling Jobs packet that is sent home. They can turn in homework for Class dojo points. Test is on Friday, April 13th.

Reading: This week we will be finishing our reading of "Lunch Money" by Andrew Clements and then taking an end of book comprehension test. Book Clubs have been formed for our Author Study on Roald Dahl. Each book club will be reading a different book by the author and completing information sheets and vocabulary on the book. The books that are being read are "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory", "James and the Giant Peach", "The BFG", and "The Witches".

Writing. We will be using the types of figurative language to begin reading, analyzing and writing our own poetry. Students will be writing many different types of poetry over the next few weeks.
