WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Social Studies: Reading Scholastic News, "The History of Halloween Candy" to practice comprehension & summarizing w/ non-fiction text IB: Exploring how "Plants and animals work interdependently to create healthy ecosystems." This week, we'll investigate which types of birds are likely to visit a bird feeder. Then students will design & create prototypes of their own bird feeders (with recycled material)
