New IB UNIT OF INQUIRY

Transdisciplinary theme: **Who we are**An inquiry into the nature of the self; beliefs and values; personal, physical, mental, social and spiritual health; human relationships including families, friends, communities, and cultures; **rights and responsibilities;** what it means to be human.

Central idea: **Humans are impacted by the continual changing nature of Earth.**

This week we will begin our unit answering the question: Could a volcano pop up in your backyard?

Religion

Chapter 4 is titled "In God's Image". Our objectives are: to appreciate the dignity of human life, discover how a failure to love lead to sin and to find God's image in creation. 2nd Step/SEL
