Nov. 26-30th **IB** focus: Inquirer

New IB UNIT OF INQUIRY Last week, we focused on how earthquakes impact humans. After watching two different videos about plate tectonics, faults and how mountains are formed, the children played a game on KAHOOTS to show their comprehension.

This next week, our guiding question is "Will a mountain last forever?" In this Mystery, students will explore how solid rock breaks apart into smaller pieces through a process called weathering (including root-wedging and ice-wedging.) In the activity, students will model the process of weathering that occurs when rocks tumble and crash into each other using sugar cubes in a container.

Religion

We will began Chapter 5, Created for One Another, on Tuesday, Nov. 13th. In this chapter we will focus on humans relationship with each other by looking at how to live in true community, doing service, and what is morality.

2nd Step/SEL

This week, we will be focusing on Lesson 9 Showing Compassion in Second Step. The children will be learning what compassion means, practice showing empathy, and demonstrate expressing concern or showing compassion for someone..
