#### **New IB UNIT OF INQUIRY**

Last week, we learned that Mountains do not last forever. Besides breaking down due to root and ice wedging we learned about the process of weathering that happens when the rocks break off and tumble and crash into each other. The children enjoyed using sugar cubes to see the process in action!

This next week's focus is on the question, "How can you survive a landslide?" In this Mystery, we will be learning about the types, causes, and dangers of landslides. The children will brainstorm ideas as if they are engineers who will design solutions for preventing landslides, protecting property and keeping people safe. Then the children will choose one of the disasters- Floods, volcanic eruption, earthquake, Wildfires, or Tsunami - and use our EPIC library to learn about one of these disasters in another country, its affects, and how people from other countries came to their aid.

#### Religion

Monday begins our Advent observation. We are using the book "Countdown to Christmas: Unwrap the Christmas Story". Each day we will be adding to our Nativity as we learn about from scripture readings.
