WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: *Ms. Long's class* <u>My Math</u> Chp. 10: Telling Time lessons 1 - 4 (Telling time to nearest hour, half hour, & quarter hour); review addition facts - quiz on Friday

ELA/Reading: *Ms. Long's Reading class* <u>Super Kids</u> Unit 3 Week 4 stories & skills focus on patterns with soft c (sounds like s) & g (sounds like j); writing with abbreviations in titles (see attached Word Workbook page for reference)

Writing: In Unit 3, we're writing & editing friendly letters to a relative or friend

Religion: In Chp. 7: Jesus Helps Us Always, we learn that Jesus helps us in times of trouble, using the metaphor of Jesus calming a storm at sea (Matthew 8:23 - 27); making Advent lapbooks & learning about Advent symbolism
