Math: Ms. Long's class My Math Chp. 4: Subtracting 2-digit Numbers test on Tuesday; Chp. 9: Interpreting Data lessons 1 - 2 (taking surveys & making picture graphs); review of partitioning shapes; please encourage your child to practice their Math facts at home ELA/Reading: Ms. Long's class Super Kids Unit 5 week 2 stories & skills focus on spelling & reading words with "schwa" sounds (short u sound with "a" & "e" spelling), using pronoun contractions, and identifying & using the "un-" prefix

Writing: Identifying nonfiction features in <u>Scholastic News</u> article, "When School was Cruel" with discussions of segregation at school & the Brown vs. the Board of Education case Religion: 1st Eucharist studies - Chp.4: We Give Thanks to God focuses on giving thanks & praise through prayer & songs at Mass, using Colossians 3: 12 - 17 to illustrate this point

IB: Exploring central idea that "Being good stewards of the Earth is our right and responsibility." Activities include exploring rules & regulations for disposing of trash & recycling in Shoreline, a Recology guest speaker, & a S. News article, "Follow that Bottle" Second Step: Bullying Prevention lesson 4 helps kids define a "bystander" & demonstrate ways that bystanders can help stop bullying in response to scenarios; home links due at end of the week
