Feb. 25-Mar. 1 IB focus: Open-Minded



New IB UNIT OF INQUIRY

In the last Mystery Science(4), students construct an explanation of how energy is stored and transferred in chain reactions, such as falling dominoes. In the activity, students are presented with an engineering design challenge to create their own chain reaction machine—a project they will continue in Mystery 5 this next week. The children were put into groups of 2 or 3. Each group talked about supplies they would bring to school to possible use in their chain reaction machine. The chain reaction machines will be constructed on Tuesday and Wednesday.

In Mystery Science 6, students are introduced to electricity as a form of energy. In the activity, students investigate how electrical energy requires a circuit and design flashlights that can turn on and off.

We have a "Google Classroom" page up that has some extra videos, readings, and activities. I sent an email last week with directions on how to get on google classroom.
