Please encourage your child to practice their Math facts at home ELA/Reading: Ms. Long's class: Super Kids Unit 5 week 3 stories & skills focus on spelling & reading words with "long a" sounds (spelled -ey, -ay, & -ei), using adjectives & adverbs, & writing verbs in past, present, & future tenses

Writing: Identifying nonfiction features in <u>Scholastic News</u> article, "Too Much Toothpaste" & learning ways to practice healthy dental hygiene

Religion: Ist Eucharist studies - Chp.5: We Learn from the Bible focuses on preparing our hearts for God's Word, using the Parable of the Sower (Mark 4: I-20) to illustrate this point IB: Exploring central idea that "Being good stewards of the Earth is our right and responsibility." We'll continue exploring rules & regulations for disposing of trash, recycling, & compost in Shoreline. We'll also learn about different products & items that are made from recycled goods, & discuss ways we can reduce the amount of waste we produce
