#### WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: Ms. Long's class My Math Chp. II: Measurement lessons 5 - 7 (relating in., ft., & yds, measuring to the nearest cm & m, & solving word problems). Please help your child practice their Math facts at home every day; subtraction facts quiz on Fri. 3/29

ELA: Ms. Long's class Super Kids Unit & week 2 stories & skills focus on spelling & reading words with open-syllable long vowels, writing with irregular plurals, & using editing marks in our writing Writing: Identifying nonfiction features in Scholastic News article, "When Annie Came to America" and learning about immigration to the U.S. Also reading "The Day it Rained Fish!" and discussing extreme weather while also charting the weather for the week.

Religion: Ist Eucharist studies - Chp. 8: We Pray as Jesus Taught Us focuses on praying & understanding the words of the Our Father prayer. We're also learning about St. Elizabeth of Hungary, a model of stewardship
