<p><b>1 Movie Trailer</b></p> <p>Create a movie trailer, showing the key points and highlights. Think about how you will show the setting, characters, and build suspense so that your audience wants to read the book!</p>	<p><b>2 Interview with the Author or Main Character</b></p> <p>Find someone to interview you as you take on the role of the author or a main character. Videotape the interview. (Try to dress as the character!)</p>	<p><b>3 Collage</b></p> <p>Make a collage that includes images (drawn, cut out, photos, etc.) and words that meet all of the requirements for this project. Use a large poster board. Focus on essential elements of the story and your review of the book.</p>
<p><b>4 Diorama</b></p> <p>Create a diorama that shows a pivotal scene from the book and includes details about the characters and setting. Be prepared to talk about the <u>meaning</u> of this scene and explain why it was important to the overall book.</p>	<p><b>5 Review of the Book</b></p> <p>Take on the role of a book reviewer. Write and illustrate a thorough review, including all of the required elements. Be persuasive about your viewpoint! This should be multiple paragraphs and approximately 1½ pages in length.</p>	<p><b>6 Google Slide Presentation</b></p> <p>Pretend that you are the author pitching your book to a prospective publisher. You have 10 minutes and up to 10 slides in which to convince them to invest in your book!</p>
<p><b>7 Test and Answer Key</b></p> <p>Create a 25-question test with a variety of question types that include important aspects of the plot, character, and setting and require meaning making. Include the answer key.</p>	<p><b>8 Three Letters</b></p> <p>Write a letter to the author and to two characters in the book! Share your opinion of the book, supported by specific examples. Demonstrate that you understand the author's purpose and theme and the characters' values and motivations.</p>	<p><b>9 Comic or Picture Book Version</b></p> <p>Show the key elements that belong in a summary and illustrate! Be thoughtful in selecting key characters and events that effectively summarize the story and give a sense of the book's theme.</p>
