New IB UNIT OF INQUIRY

In our next two Mystery Science lessons, students will first explore how heat is another form of energy that can make things go. In the activity for this lesson, students create their own heat engines to turn a fan. Then, in the next Mystery Science lesson, students will analyze the advantages and disadvantages of different sources of energy, including burnable fuels and alternative (renewable) energies. In the activity, students choose different energy sources to power a town.
