WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: Ms. Long's class My Math Chp. II: Measurement lessons II, 12, & chapter review (using number lines & recording data on line plots). Extra practice with problem solving skills in word problems, & Chp. II test on Wed. 4/10. Please help your child practice their Math facts at home every day.

ELA: Ms. Long's class No new Super Kids unit due to conferences. Doing phonics, spelling, comprehension, and fluency progress checks, and we will share this data at conferences this week. Writing: Identifying nonfiction features in Scholastic News article, "Rainbow Plants" and practicing comparing & contrasting info about plants, read life cycle charts, and using text to provide evidence. Finishing action plans to help the people of Mabul Religion: Ist Eucharist studies, Chp. 9: Jesus is Present with Us Now focuses on ways Jesus is present with us now (Luke 24:13-35).
