WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: Ms. Long's class My Math Chp. 6: 3-Digit Addition lessons 2 - 5 (strategies for adding by 10's, 100's, & with regrouping). Extra practice with problem solving skills in word problems. Please help your child practice their Math facts at home every day.

ELA: Ms. Long's class Super Kids Unit 6 week 4 stories & skills focus on spelling & reading compound words with some-, any-, no-, and every- patterns, and identifying/writing with singular & plural pronouns. Book Club vocabulary and comprehension skills work with the book, Pinky and Rex and the Bully

Writing: Identifying nonfiction features in <u>Scholastic News</u> article, "Recycle that Gum." Also practicing paragraph writing skills with unit 6 week 4 Super Kids stories.

Religion: Ist Eucharist studies, Chp. 10: We are Sent Forth to Share Love uses the story of Jesus Washing the Disciples' Feet to help kids identify ways that Jesus served others, and how we can serve others today. We'll also make a Holy Week book to discuss events & symbolism, attend a Stations of the Cross presentation, and read <u>Benjamin's Box</u> as we do a Resurrection Eggs activity IB: Exploring a new IB unit (with Mystery Science) with the central idea that "Wind and water erosion occur quickly or slowly and change the land." This week, we'll construct models of Earth's surface to learn how rivers flow.
