#### WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: Ms. Long's class My Math Chp. 12: Geometric Shapes lessons 1 - 4 (2D shapes, 3D shapes, & sides & angles). Review of place value & counting money. Please help your child practice their addition & subtraction Math facts daily (5 min.). All students' goals are to pass Level 2 tests by the end of the year

ELA: Ms. Long's class Super Kids Unit 7 week 2 stories & skills focus on spelling & reading words with long e patterns, identifying homonyms, and writing with the suffix -ness. Also practicing comprehension & vocab skills with non-fiction articles in unit 7 Super Magazine themed around water

Writing: Identifying nonfiction features in <u>Scholastic News</u> article, "A Plastic Straw Problem" & crafting an argument in favor of or against banning plastic straws. Also working on SuperKids lessons to help students write personal stories

Religion: Reflecting on First Eucharist

IB: Exploring our Water & Wind Erosion IB unit with the central idea that "Wind and water erosion occur quickly or slowly and change the land." This week, students will explore the question, "What's Strong Enough to Make a Canyon?" Students will use a model of rain and land to explain what causes a canyon to form
