#### WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: Ms. Long's class My Math Chp. 12: Geometric Shapes lessons 5 - 8 (partitioning shapes & identifying fractions). Review of counting money. Please also help your child practice their addition & subtraction Math facts daily (5 min.). All students' goals are to pass Level 2 tests by the end of the year

ELA: Ms. Long's class Super Kids Unit 7 week 3 stories & skills focus on spelling & reading words with long i patterns, identifying & writing with onomatopoeia, and writing with quotation marks.

Also practicing comprehension, writing, & vocab skills with Super Kids Book Club book, Love and Roast Chicken

Writing: Identifying nonfiction features in <u>Scholastic News</u> article, "Garden Defender," & learning how ladybugs help gardens. Also working on SuperKids lessons to help students write first drafts, then edit, personal stories

Religion: Discussing symbolism of shamrocks and the Holy Trinity; reviewing Mass order & receiving Communion for Mass on Thurs.

IB: Exploring our Water & Wind Erosion IB unit with the central idea that "Wind and water erosion occur quickly or slowly and change the land." This week, students will explore the question, "How can you stop a landslide?" Students will compare multiple solutions for preventing erosion by designing and testing ways to keep water from washing away a hill modeled out of cornmeal.
