## WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: Using Beginning-of-Year My Math & supplemental tests to assess number sense, counting, addition & subtraction skills, & facts fluency. We'll start our My Math curriculum next week, & you can expect to see daily homework coming home starting next week

ELA/Reading: Assessing reading fluency (DIBELS), foundational reading & phonics skills (Super Kids BOY), handwriting, and reading levels (Reading A to Z) to help determine reading groups; using "Welcome Back Superkids" review workbook to review Kindergarten phonics & spelling skills. Scholastic News nonfiction weekly article teaches kids about being good citizens in the classroom & at school Religion: Using Call to Faith. Chp. I: "God Made You!" explains the creation story & teaches how we're uniquely made in God's image

IB: Mystery Science mini-lesson on inventions focuses on the important role of "failure" in the process of developing solutions to problems. Students created & tested multiple paper-engineered inventions to save Bobby, a falling bobby pin.
