### Next up: Fall activities, apples, and exploration!

The students completed their first full week of school and it was a big one! We wrapped up our "Chicka Chicka, Boom Boom" unit with a fun art project where the children glued the letters in their name "up the coconut tree". You will be able to view these beautiful pieces of art in our classroom.

I hope you all enjoyed the video of the children interacting with Mrs. Halvorson as she read the book to the class. Their enthusiasm and participation is a delight to witness!
