WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: My Math Chp. 3: Addition Strategies to 20, lessons 4 - 6 (Using doubles & near doubles to add & solve addition problems) ELA/Reading: Super Kids, Unit 5 lessons 182 - 185 stories & skills focus on spelling & writing words with -ing & -ed ending sounds, identifying action verbs, using antonyms, and recognizing character traits. Reading <u>Scholastic News</u> article, "Long Ago Neighbors," a Thanksgiving-themed article that teaches about the Wampanoag & Pilgrims lived similar & different lives Writing: Unit 5 focuses on descriptive writing, teaching how to write descriptions of physical traits- how something looks and feels- and personality traits- how someone acts. Kids will use both their observation skills and their imaginations in this work Religion: Unit 2: Jesus, Our Lord and Savior. In session 8, Trust in God, we'll learn the difference between needs & wants through praying the Lord's Prayer; oral assessment of prayers IB: Wrapping up our HOW WE ORGANIZE OURSELVES IB unit with the central idea that "Exploring light and sound allows humans to create fun & useful things." This week, students will visit MOPOP for a workshop on the "Science of Sound," & will design something to communicate with sound & light from a distance Second Step: In Bullying Prevention Unit lesson 2, students learn how to identify & report bullying to a caring adult
