## WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: My Math Chp. 3: Addition Strategies to 20, lessons 7 - 9 (Make 10 to add, add in any order, adding 3 numbers); test on Fri. ELA/Reading: Super Kids, Unit 5 lessons 186 - 189 stories & skills focus on spelling & writing words with -ing & -ed ending sounds, identifying action verbs, using antonyms, and recognizing character traits. Reading Super Duper magazine with "Lost!" theme; reading u. 5 Book Club books. Reading Scholastic News article, "It's Winter, Reindeer!" that teaches about unique animal adaptations to help them survive harsh winters

Writing: Unit 5 focuses on descriptive writing, teaching how to write descriptions of physical traits- how something looks and feels- and personality traits- how someone acts.

Religion: During Advent, we'll study the history of Advent calendars & symbols, as well as Jesus' arrival at Christmas Second Step: In Bullying Prevention Unit lesson 3, students learn how to refuse bullying when it happens

IB: Starting our HOW WE EXPRESS OURSELVES IB unit with the central idea that "Christmas is celebrated around the world." Students will learn how different cultures & countries around the world celebrate Christmas through books, videos, & interactive Christmas-themed activities
