WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: My Math Chp. 4: Subtraction Strategies to 20, lessons 1 - 4 (Counting back, use number lines, use doubles, & problem solving) ELA/Reading: Super Kids, Unit 5 lessons 190 - 193 stories & skills focus on spelling & writing words with long & short vowel sounds, identifying dialogue, & writing with quotation marks. Writing: Unit & focuses on informational writing. Children will first make a list of topics they know a lot about, and then write facts and draw diagrams for some of those topics. Their work will be collected in a class book.

Religion: In unit 2 lesson 9, "Jesus Rises from the Dead" we'll study Jesus' Resurrection story & recognize how Jesus is always with us. During this 2nd Week of Advent, we'll also focus on how we can bring peace to the world, reading The Peace Book by Todd Parr & writing original poetry on peace

Second Step: In Bullying Prevention Unit lesson 4, students learn how to bystanders can help prevent bullying

IB: Working in our HOW WE EXPRESS OURSELVES IB unit with the central idea that "Christmas is celebrated around the world." Students are learning how different cultures & countries around the world celebrate Christmas through books, videos, & interactive Christmas-themed activities
