WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: My Math Chp. 4: Subtraction Strategies to 20, lessons 7 - 8 (Fact families, missing addends, & review of word problems); test on Fri.; review Fall topics for MAP testing at end of month

ELA/Reading: Super Kids, Unit 7 lessons 197 - 200 stories & skills focus on spelling words with long vowel + silent e sounds, marking long vowels, & teaching sequence with plot Writing: Unit 7 focuses on opinion writing. Children will write opinions and supporting reasons in response to thought-provoking questions

Religion: In Unit 3 session II: Following Jesus, we'll learn about being good friends through the example of Jesus & his apostles; also discussing Epiphany meaning & symbolism IB: Starting our HOW THE WORLD WORKS Mystery Science unit, "Patterns and cycles help people understand the Earth." This week, students will investigate what it takes to make a stationary object's shadow move, & relate these observations to shadows changing throughout the day and the Sun's position moving across the sky
