Chapter 6: Divide by a One Digit Number

In this chapter the children will be dividing with one digit divisors. They will begin by dividing by multiples of 10, 100, and 1000 and estimating quotients and then move to dividing with remainders and interpreting whether those remainders caused you to go one up or one down in your quotient. Finally, they will move to more complex problems.

Chapter 5: Adding and Subtracting Decimals

The children will be estimating sums and differences, working on number sense using hands on materials to add and subtract decimals, and practice adding and subtracting decimals.

Chapter 6: Multiply and Divide Decimals
