WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: My Math Chp. 6: 2-Digit Addition lessons 2 - 4 (Count on 10s and 1s, Add 10s and 1s, & Problem Solving Strategies); review subtraction facts, taking timed test on Friday (we'll test on these + & - facts every 2 weeks)

ELA/Reading: Super Kids, Unit 10 lessons 223 - 226 stories & skills focus on spelling contractions with "not" & compound words. Reading SUPER DUPER article on homing pigeons. Reading Scholastic News article, "Smile Like a Crocodile," to learn about how the shape of different animal's teeth helps them in various ways. Continuing to read biographies of African American heroes for Black History Month

Writing: Unit 10 builds on the narrative writing done in unit 9, asking students to edit & write final drafts of a personal narrative (from u.9). Students write about an important event in their lives, using sequence words to include a beginning, middle, and end

Religion: Preparing for Lent by learning about Lenten symbols & the traditions & history of Mardi Gras & Ash Wednesday. Also studying St. Andre Bessette as part of Lenten virtues unit

Second Step: Unit 2, lesson 9 helps students identify their feelings - as well as others' feelings

IB: Working in our WHERE WE ARE IN PLACE & TIME IB unit with the central idea that How Families Live Around the World is Shaped by Environment.

This week students will learn about how families in North & South American countries live, go to school, get food, shop, play, etc. Students will complete a visa page in their own passports as they "Visit" Canada, Mexico, Argentina, & Brazil
