## IB UNIT OF INQUIRY Regions

Transdisciplinary Theme: Who we are

Unit Central Idea: Regions are formed based on

shared characteristics

This is an inquiry into....

Regions have defining characteristics

- 2. Examples of borders that have recognizable features
- 3. People influence the formation of regions.

Teacher questions/provocations that will drive these inquiries are:

- 1. Why do regions change? What is a region?
- What are defining characteristics of the 50 states and where are the states in relation to one another.
- What are the differences and similarities in physical, political, and cultural characteristics of Mexico, US and Canada? How can you display these on a map?

We have almost finished our research on the cultural regions of Mexico and Canada. Once finished we will share what we have learned by presenting the book to the class. Once finished we will move on and begin looking at the regions within the United States of America. Your child will be asked to name and place as many of the state as they can in a blank map of the United States. They will then be given a map with the state written in and can see how they did. Our hope is then to use our IPADS to play the app "Stack the States" so we can practice learning all of the states in a fun way.
