Chapter 7: Patterns and Sequences

In this chapter the children will: describe nonnumeric growing and repeating patterns, identify, describe, and extend numeric patterns, extend patterns and write observations about the pattern, look for a pattern to solve problems, find and use rules to write addition and subtraction equations, find and use rules to write multiplication and division equations, use order of operations to solve problems, explore equations with two operations, and use tables to recognize and write equations with two operations

Chapter 6: Multiply and Divide Decimals

The children will be estimating, and learning to multiply decimals by whole numbers and other decimals. They will also be multiplying by powers of ten and reviewing the multiplication properties. In division of decimals, they will begin with estimating and learning to divide decimals by whole numbers and other decimals as well as powers of ten.
