WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: My Math Chp. 6: 2-Digit Addition lessons 5 - 8 (Adding with Regrouping, Subtracting 10s, Counting back by 10s, & Relating Addition & Subtraction of 10s); review subtraction facts, taking timed test on Friday (we'll test on + & - facts every 2 weeks)

ELA/Reading: Super Kids, Unit 11 lessons 227 - 230 stories & skills focus on spelling words with "y" that sounds like long i, long e, & /ay/ that sounds like long a. Reading Scholastic News article, "Make Way for Ducklings," to learn about ducklings & to compare fiction & non-fiction texts

Writing: Finishing Unit 10 narrative writing final drafts of a personal narrative. Starting unit 11, which focuses on how-to writing, & students will work together to write a recipe

Religion: Preparing for Lent by learning Lenten symbols & traditions, & studying St. Andre Bessette, an example of diligence

Second Step: Unit 2, lesson 10 helps students recognize when they've made a mistake/accident, and learn to accept responsibility and apologize if they have made mistakes

Ib: Working in our WHERE WE ARE IN PLACE & TIME IB unit with the central idea that How Families Live Around the World is Shaped by Environment. This week students will learn about how families in Australia, Antarctica, & Asia countries live, go to school, get food, shop, play, etc. Students will complete a visa page in their own passports as they "visit" Canada, Mexico, Argentina, & Brazil
