WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math: My Math Chp. 6: 2-Digit Addition test on Tues. Chp. 7: Organize & Use Graphs lessons I & 2 (Tally charts & making tables); review addition facts, taking timed test on Friday (we'll test every 2 weeks)

ELA/Reading: Super Kids, Unit II lessons 23I - 233 stories & skills focus on spelling words with "y" or "ay" that sounds like long i, long e, or long a. Reading Scholastic News article, "Don't Mess with this Dad!" to learn how frog dads care for their eggs & life cycles of frogs

Writing: Unit II focuses on how-to writing, & students will work together to write a recipe. They'll also compile a list they know "how to" do, & pick a topic to write about, detailing materials needed & the steps you'd take. Also doing a "Who is Worth More than Gold?" St. Patrick's Day themed writing prompt

Religion: Preparing for Lent by studying a saint who demonstrates a specific Lenten virtue chosen for the week. This week we're learning about St. Albert the Great, an example of studiousness Second Step: Unit 2, lesson 11 helps students learn how to show compassion (care & concern) to others

IB: Working in our WHERE WE ARE IN PLACE & TIME IB unit with the central idea that How Families Live Around the World is Shaped by Environment. This week students will learn about how families in European & Asian countries live, go to school, get food, shop, play, etc. Students will complete a visa page for their passports as they "visit" 2-3 countries within each continent
