• Ms. Bakamis's class needs to check their **Bakamis Math Class** Google Classroom daily for specific learning assignments. This week we will wrap up our lessons in Chapter 9: Adding & Subtracting Fractions. For more specific topics covered refer to the 5B Week-at-a-Glance. ***Our Chapter 9 Math Test will be on Friday and the students will have until Sunday evening to complete it.*** All students will be required to complete at least 45 minutes of ALEKS/week in the third trimester. Going forward, this assignment will be worth 10 points per week. Emails will be sent out on Fridays to notify you of your student's progress towards this expectation.

• Mrs. Smith's class will continue working in Chapter 8, "Fractions and Decimals." They will be Comparing Fractions, Write Fractions as Decimals and review Chapter 8. ***There will be a test over Chapter 8 on Friday.*** All students are required to complete at least 45 minutes of ALEKS/week in the third trimester. Going forward, this assignment will be worth 10 points per week. Emails will be sent out on Fridays to notify you of your student's progress towards this expectation.

5B Reading & Writing (ELA)

• **Reading & Writing:** Students will be responsible for reading *American Revolution for Kids: A History with 21 Activities* on **Epic!** (our class code is: tdr9567) and completing the AR Quiz on this when they are done. We have extended the ***due date for this assignment until Friday, May 15th.***

• **Spelling:** We will continue with our new Spelling lists this week. Please practice this week. We will be taking our Spelling Tests on Friday. If you (or another adult) could please say the words, then the students will write down the words. The students will take a picture of their test & then upload it to the assignment on Google Classroom (just like we did 2 weeks ago)!

5B Religion: Students will review the Beatitudes and will create a representation of the assigned beatitude and will upload a picture, google doc, video, etc. of what it means to them.

5B Social Studies IB Unit: Students will finish watching episodes 40 of *Liberty's Kids* this week and will reflect on what they've seen & learned. The assignment will be posted in Google Classroom

5B Science: Students will begin exploring our new Science Unit - Chemical Magic. Students will have access to our Mystery Science Lessons 1 - Lessons 4 (videos posted on Google Classroom) this week. After each video, the students will be expected to fill-out an electronic reflection about the lesson for the day. At the end of the week (during our Friday check-in) we will be reflecting on what we've learned so far. Students will also be encouraged to read books related to this topic on **Epic!** (our class code is: tdr9567).
