• Ms. Bakamis's class needs to check their **Bakamis Math Class** Google Classroom daily for specific learning assignments. This week we will continue our lessons in Chapter 10: Multiply & Divide Fractions. For more specific topics covered refer to the 5B Week-at-a-Glance. All students will be required to complete at least 45 minutes of ALEKS/week in the third trimester. Going forward, this assignment will be worth 10 points per week. Emails will be sent out on Thursday to notify you of your student's progress towards this expectation.

• Mrs. Smith's class will continue working in Chapter 9: Adding and Subtracting Fractions. Students will be adding and subtracting unlike fractions (fractions with different denominators) this week. This is challenging for most students because there are a lot of steps. It's very important that all Mrs. Smith Math students attend class this week! "How-To" videos are posted in Google 5A Mrs. Smith Math Class also in case students forget how to do the math or miss class.
