• Ms. Bakamis's class needs to check their **Bakamis Math Class** Google Classroom daily for specific learning assignments. This week we will wrap up our lessons in Chapter 10: Multiply & Divide Fractions. *Our Chapter 10 Test will be on Friday, June 5th!* For more specific topics covered refer to the 5B Week-at-a-Glance. All students will be required to complete at least 45 minutes of ALEKS/week in the third trimester. Going forward, this assignment will be worth 10 points per week. Emails will be sent out on Thursday to notify you of your student's progress towards this expectation.

• Mrs. Smith's class will finish working in Chapter 9 this week: Adding and Subtracting Fractions. Students will be adding and subtracting mixed numbers this week. This is challenging for most students because there are a lot of steps. **It's very important that all Mrs. Smith Math students attend class this week**! 5B Reading & Writing (ELA)
