			Main character's overall goal and struggle are clear
			Main character's problem increases until there is a change and resolution
			Important parts are written with SHOWING detail
			Unimportant parts were taken out of the final story
			Transitions connect ideas and show passage of time
			Story is organized with a beginning, middle, and end that all connect
			Story is divided into paragraphs for different parts & times or to show when a new character is speaking
			Formatting requirements of length and font choice are met
			Proper spelling, grammar, usage, and conventions are used throughout
