They will have from November 18-30th to work on these projects. The children will be given time to share their project via Zoom. The day for each child's presentation will be assigned on the weekly schedule sent out on November 20th. At this presentation, the audience will have the opportunity to ask 3 questions and give 3 compliments.

Thursday, November 19, we have the opportunity to participate in a virtual workshop sponsored by Seattle City Light. This workshop "Renewable Energy" teaches the students where their electrical energy comes from and why energy conservation is important. The class will explore the concepts of system inputs and outputs and different forms of renewable energy, with an emphasis on hydropower.

With the number of Covid cases growing, Mr. Boyle has made the decision to stop in person school masses for now. So our scheduled 3rd grade mass next Friday is cancelled. We look forward to the day when we can all gather together for mass and for school. Governor Inslee's advice for the upcoming Thanksgiving and Holiday celebrations reminds us to limit our gatherings.
