In lesson 5 we'll explore answers to, "Why don't trees blow down in the wind?" and examine how tree structures (roots, leaves, etc.) keep trees from blowing down. Students will use their observations to create "tree umbrellas" to stand up to the wind, participate in "wind" powered relay races, go on a wind walk, and create their own wind-carrying kites

Art: Finishing "wacky" animals to practice scale & shape; designing and constructing unique kites
