Student Routines

- If late, get an admit slip from the office.
- Organize for each class; pack up for the morning and again after lunch
- Write down homework & long-term projects (paper or digital)
- Plan ahead (Calendar)
- Check Classroom & PowerSchool regularly

Uniforms: A Reminder

Shirts:

- White or red polo - short or long sleeves
- White or red turtleneck - mock or regular
- White oxford shirt - short or long sleeves



Pants/Skirts:

- Navy pleated or flat front twill pants
- Navy pleated or flat front walk shorts
- Correct plaid skirt with shorts under

Uniforms: A Reminder

Outerwear:

- Navy cardigan
- Navy fleece vest or jacket
- Navy sweater or vest
- Navy sweatshirt (crew neck or hooded)

MYP Only:

- Gray cardigan
- Gray sweater or vest
- Gray sweatshirt (crew neck or hooded)

Shoes:

- Weather appropriate
- Coordinate well with uniform
- No more than 1" above ankle

Socks:

- Solid colored
- Coming to the ankle bone or higher (no anklets/footies)
- Knee-highs
- Tights



Non-Uniform: Do Not Wear

- No sandals
- No open-toed or backless shoes
- No flip-flops, crocs, or water shoes;
- No neon colors (socks or shoes)
- No footless tights or leggings

Drop Off



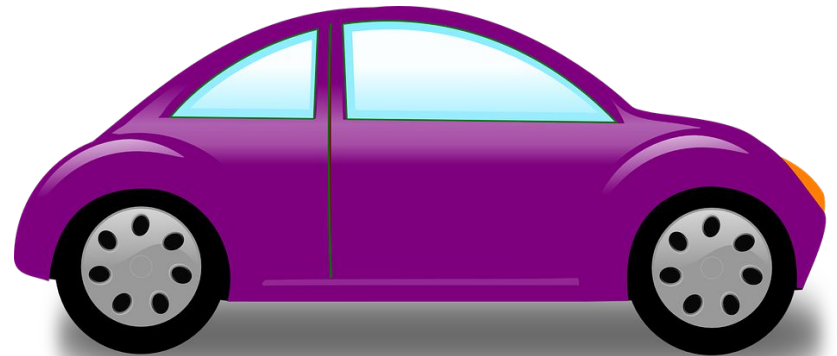
- Come only at your assigned drop off time (by last name)
- Carpool time by youngest student
- Take student temperature at home (< 100°)
- Fill out the JotForm ahead of time to show at arrival
- Temperature taken at school

Drop Off Schedule

Drop-off times (for families without Preschool siblings):

- 8:00 -8:10 a.m.: last name beginning with A-E
- 8:10 - 8:20 a.m.: last name beginning with F-L
- 8:20 - 8:30 a.m.: last name beginning with M - R
- 8:30 - 8: 40 a.m.: last name beginning with S - Z



Covid Protocols in Class

- Masks required---extras in the backpack a good idea
- 3 feet between desks
- 3 feet and silent transitions between classes

Dismissal

 - d. Gr. 7 Ms. Fargo in lane 4
 - e. Gr. 8 - both classes in lane 5
 - If dismissing with a sibling, go to his or her homeroom at the correct time.
 - Extension open
