At the start of this week we will be MAP testing. This is such a great piece of data to see how much the students grow throughout the year. Please make sure your student gets lots of rest and eats a solid breakfast. Here's where we're headed this week in the classroom:

In **Writing** *with Mr. Scholz*, we will continue our narrative writing unit by exploring strategies that build on our "small moment story" from last week, and dig into the grammar tools we need to write efficiently.

This week in **Science** we will begin our first unit on how organic matter cycles through our living world in systems of interdependent parts. Many of our lessons will focus on ecology and will help the students develop the idea that plants, animals, and fungi form a system of interdependent parts, with each part dependent on the other parts for its material nourishment.

In **Religion** this week we will continue in our first unit on God, Our Creator and Father. In this unit, we will learn about how God creates us, how God saves us, God's Revelation, how God directs our lives, how we celebrate Ordinary Time.

This week in **Math** *with Ms. Bakamis* & *Mr. Scholz*, we will begin our first unit entitled "Place Value and Number Relationships." In this unit we will learn how to generalize place value, extend place value to decimals, read & write decimals, compare decimals, & use place value to round decimals. In

Math *with Mr. Carson*, we will start our unit on Proportions and Ratios. This is an introduction to SLOPE and we will make the connection between Proportional Relationships, Direct Variation, and Slope! Our weekly ALEKS expectation will be that each student completes at least 5 topics by Sunday night.

In the **Library** with Mrs. Feucht, we will continue our lessons on Digital Citizenship. These lessons include the following topics: Media Balance and Well-Being: What does media balance mean for me?, Privacy and Security: What is clickbait and how can you avoid it?, Digital Footprint and Identity: How do gender stereotypes shape our experiences online?, Relationships and Communication: How do you keep online friendships safe?, Cyberbullying and Digital Drama: What is cyberbullying and what can you do to stop it?, News and Media Literacy: What are the important parts of an online news article?.

This week in **Reading** *with Ms. Bakamis*, we will continue to read books within our reading levels and focus on our comprehension skills. We will be sharing our Summer Book Reports with our peers. As a nightly practice, the students will be expected to complete at LEAST 30 minutes of reading. *Our first trimester AR goal is 15 points!*
