Here's where we're headed this week in the classroom:

This week in **Writing** *with Mr. Scholz*, we will continue to work on our informational writing project by considering the importance of geography for our historical topic of Westward Expansion. We also continue with "Grammar Mondays." This week our MobyMax online practice and interactive notebooks will help us with the crucial skill of comma use (one of the quickest and easiest tools for clarity of meaning!).

In **Social Studies** we will continue our unit entitled "Opportunity motivates people to leave home." This is an exciting unit where we will be learning in groups to sail to the "New World" and establish our new colonies. Students will be working on their group work skills through this adventure.

In **Religion** this week we will continue our discussions aboutAdvent and Unit 2 entitled "Jesus, Our Lord and Savior." In this unit our lessons focus on St. Alphonsus Liguori, the New Life in Jesus, Meeting Jesus, Baptized into Christ, Growing in the Spirit, and Celebrating Advent.

This week in Math with Ms. Bakamis & Mr. Scholz, we review Unit 6, "Multiply Decimals." Our Math test will be on Wednesday, December 14th. In Math with Mr. Carson, we have completed our Unit 4 Test on Integers and Rational numbers.
