Happy first week of school! It has been great getting to know your students this past few days. This upcoming week is packed with exciting learning experiences. Here's where we're headed:

This week in **Reading & Spelling** *with Ms. Bakamis*, we will focus on our comprehension skills. We will also be learning about different genres and reviewing our **Summer Reading assignment due Friday (9/15).** As a nightly practice, each student will be expected to complete at LEAST 30 minutes of reading. *Our first trimester AR goal is 15 points!*

In **Writing** *with Mr. Scholz*, students will be setting up their grammar notebook and developing ideas for a "small moment story," as we launch our narrative writing unit centered on the power of language to powerfully share real stories from our lives.

This week in **Science** we continue our first unit on how organic matter cycles through our living world, in systems of interdependent parts. Many of our lessons will focus on ecology and will help the students develop the idea that plants, animals, and fungi form a system of interdependent parts, with each part dependent on the other parts for its material nourishment. This helps us highlight our IB curriculum unit "Ecosystems are a vital aspect of the world around us," with a focus on our Key Concepts of *change* and *connection*.

In **Religion** this week, our inquiry centers on "God, Our Creator and Father." In this unit, we will learn about how God creates us, how God saves us, God's Revelation, how God directs our lives, how we celebrate Ordinary Time. Our saint for the unit is St. Augustine. Since we will be celebrating the Mass of the Holy Spirit on Wednesday, 9/13, we will consider how the Holy Spirit is present in our own lives.

This week in **Math** *with Ms. Bakamis* & *Mr. Scholz*, we will begin our first unit entitled "Place Value and Number Relationships." In this unit we will learn how to generalize place value, extend place value to decimals, read & write decimals, compare decimals, & use place value to round decimals. We

are excited to have Mr. Carson as our math coach for this year, as he rotates through our classes to provide support and challenge for our students. Our weekly ALEKS expectation is that each student completes at LEAST 5 topics (& at LEAST 45 minutes) by Sunday night.
