Directions:

1. Use your journal to help you remember what you learned at the farm.
2. Students log into Toddle. www.toddleapp.com They can use their student code on the back of their planner in their binder near their QR code.
3. Once logged in to their Toddle account, students go to the to-do list and look for the assignment named "Apple Farm Field Trip Reflection"
4. Scroll down past the learning intentions and choose to type a remark in the box as your reflection, or go to the red button that says + Add work and choose voice to record your reflection.
5. When you are finished, mark it as done.

- What do you know about the apple life cycle?
- What do you still wonder about the apple life cycle?
- What is your favorite part of the field?
- What was memorable about the field trip?
